

**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
(NOTICE BY PUBLICATION OF SPECIAL DISTRICT ELECTION)**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and, particularly, to the electors of the **West Metro Fire Protection District** of Jefferson and Douglas Counties, Colorado.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held on May 2, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At that time, three directors will be elected to serve 4-year terms for Director Districts 4, 6, and 7. The Director Districts are generally described below:

Director District 4

Director District 4 generally encompasses an area from portions of Colfax Ave, W. 12th Ave, and US Highway 6 on the North, portions of W. Kentucky Dr, W. Mississippi Ave, and W. Jewell Avenue on the South, S. Union Blvd on the West, and S. Sheridan Blvd on the East.

Director District 6

Director District 6 generally encompasses the following areas:

An area from US 285 on the North, the WMFPD district boundary on the South and West, and portions of S. Simms St, S. Kipling St, and C470 at Wadsworth Blvd on the East. An area from W. Waterton Rd on the North, the WMFPD district boundary on the South, West, and East. This is the Roxborough community.

Director District 7

Director District 7 generally encompasses an area from portions of W. Quincy Avenue and W. Belleview Ave on the North, portions of W. Ken Caryl Ave and W. Chatfield Ave on the South, S. Simms St on the West, and the WMFPD district boundary on the East.



The Office of the DEO is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If the DEO determines that a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form is not sufficient, the eligible elector who submitted the form may amend the form once, at any time, prior to 4:00 p.m. on **Friday, February 24, 2023**, the deadline for submission of a signed and witnessed Self-Nomination and Acceptance form.

Affidavit of Intent To Be A Write-In-Candidate forms must be submitted to the office of the DEO by 3:00 p.m. on **February 27, 2023** (the sixty-fourth day before the election).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, an application for absentee ballot shall be filed with the designated election official no later than the close of business on **Tuesday** immediately preceding the election, **April 25, 2023**.
